

SPIRITUAL DIRECTION (ADV CERT)

Admissions

All those looking to apply must have or submit:

- a Master of Arts (M.A.) degree in theology, ministry, or a related field;
- nine graduate credits in fundamental theology and sacred scripture (which may have been taken as part of, or separately from, the master's degree coursework);
- evidence of at least one year of experience in ministry or under spiritual direction;
- a letter of recommendation from a religious superior or spiritual director.

One cannot consider being a spiritual director without first fostering one's own spiritual life. Students who feel drawn to this ministry are advised to start by seeking a spiritual director for themselves. Participation in monthly spiritual direction with a credentialed spiritual director for at least one year is a prerequisite for admission to this program. However, in some circumstances, if an applicant has met all other admission requirements, they may contact the program director to request a waiver of this requirement. Students are expected to continue in spiritual direction throughout their course of studies.
