SPIRITUAL DIRECTION (ADV CERT)

Overview

The advanced certificate in spiritual direction is designed to assess a student's potential to become a spiritual director, and it supports students in their efforts to:

- · discern a call to this ministry;
- · formulate a model of spiritual direction and chaplaincy, and
- · develop the specific skills required to serve as a spiritual director.

Graduates of the program serve as high school and college campus ministers, retreat directors, and spiritual directors.

Student Learning Outcomes

- Students will demonstrate facilities with methods of research in specific theological disciplines for post graduate and doctoral studies.
- Students will communicate the Christian story competently to make it accessible through a variety of means (e.g. teaching, writing, dialogue, personal consultation).
- Students will articulate the relationship between the Christian tradition and their professional practice and spiritual development.
- Students will articulate a well-rounded knowledge and critical appropriation of Jesuit Spirituality and the Catholic intellectual tradition.
- Students will use tools of literary, cultural, historical, and social analysis in the interpretation of various cultures and their relationship to the Christian tradition.
- Students will demonstrate a well-rounded and critical appropriation
 of effective ministerial skill in ecclesial, congregational, and
 institutional settings with theological understanding and practical
 skills consistent with his/her specialization.
