Admissions

Other than a bachelor's degree with a minimum GPA of 3.0 (or equivalent) and working proficiency in the English language, the master of science in applied health informatics does not have any prerequisites. Academic performance, standardized test scores, where applicable (GRE, MCAT, GMAT, ESL, IELTS etc.), personal statements demonstrating the ability to effectively communicate technological concepts, and strong recommendations will provide the basis of the admissions committee's decision. The committee will also consider the nature and extent of previous work experience, including any health care experience. Candidates are not expected to know a programming language prior to applying.
