

# IGNITE SCHOLARS PROGRAM BUSINESS CORE

Students in the Gabelli School of Business' Ignite Scholars Program are required to complete **13 business core courses**<sup>3</sup> plus **four integrated project (IP) courses** in their business core curriculum, as follows. They also complete additional program-specific coursework.

<sup>1</sup> Students take a special section of this course designated for Ignite Scholars.

<sup>2</sup> Certain 3-credit business core courses are split into two 1.5-credit courses; in such cases, those two courses do not count separately, but rather count together as one course.

<sup>3</sup> Integrated Projects (IPs) are semester-long projects that use knowledge from the business core and apply it to real-world circumstances. Students complete one IP per year during their four-year program. All four projects must be completed in order to graduate.

<sup>4</sup> This course may double-count as a liberal arts elective. Students who join the Ignite Scholars Program after their first year fulfill this requirement with HPCB 4801 Ignite Scholars Readings -SO.

<sup>5</sup> Credits earned as part of the capstone project may count towards liberal arts or free electives for Global Business majors.

<sup>6</sup> This course may double-count as an elective toward the student's major.
